Working and non-working models, prototypes, simulation etc. are invited in this category.

- Only one exhibit from each group from each institution will be entertained.
- Participants are requested to bring themselves the material supporting their exhibits/models like charts, posters etc.
- Any requirement for power supply or any other item shall be conveyed to us well in advance so that the proper arrangement can be made.
- The organizing committee is committed to provide you with every possible support but does not guarantee you the availability of every item.
- A one page abstract of the project would be appreciated if enclosed along with the entry form.
- The project will be shortlisted / screened / selected on the basis of abstract and performance during the exhibition.

1) Poster Making Competition:-

- Only two can participate in each group from an institution.
- The topic for poster will be:-
 - Group A : Make science a boon not a curse
 - Group B : Modify chemical weapons into useful chemical drugs.
 - Group C : Enrich plasma avoid nuclear holocaust.
- Time allowed will be 1 hour only.
- The Drawing sheet will be provided by us.
- Participants are requested to bring their own drawing material and color etc.

2) Science Based Drama :-

- Only one script will be entertained from an institution.

- A team can consist of 8 participants at the max.
- The team should come prepared with their entire work withal.
- The skit theme should be innovative ; science based and scientific message conveying.
- Time allowed will be 20 minutes (including stage setup)
An overview of the script is required to be submitted along with the entry form.

1) Quiz Competition:-

- Only one team (2 participants) are invited from each institution.
A team should consist of two participants.
- The team has to undergo various screening rounds before they go to final round.
- Participants of quiz competition are required to turn up in their respective uniforms.
- Other rules will be notified on the spot.

Guideline for GHTE-2015

- Only 2 teams (senior-junior) 4 participants from each institution are invited for National event.
- Generic rules applicable.
- Round and themes will be conveyed then and there only.
- On the spot registration, closes 1/2 hour before the commencement of the event.
- Participants are required to bring their day to day use items with them.
- Prior registration for each competition required.
